Under the general direction of the Chief of Police or designee and under direct supervision of the Patrol Division Commander, the CARD Director is responsible for planning, supervising, and reviewing the activities of all personnel, liaisons, chaplains, volunteers, and any other entity that has been approved by the chief of police pertaining to the CARD program. This is a new position with the opportunity to develop and grow this program from the ground up.

Candidates must possess a Masters of Social Work, a minimum of four years of crisis intervention and the ability to apply principles DSM-5 and diagnostic skills. Base salary for the position is \$63,000. Candidate must be willing to work 12 hour shifts and every other weekend.
