The City of Mount Vernon is hosting a Civil Service test for a Public Utility - Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations & Maintenance Technician I.

Applications: To download an application, visit www.mountvernonohio.org, click on the Careers tab, and click on the Civil Service Employee Application, which is towards the bottom of the page. Applications can also be picked up in the Safety Service Office (second floor) at City Hall, located at 40 Public Square in Mount Vernon.

Apply: Submit your Civil Service Employee Application (resume is optional) to afrye@mountvernonohio.org, or you can drop off your Civil Service Employee Application (resume is optional) at the Civil Service Office (second floor) at City Hall, located at 40 Public Square in Mount Vernon.

Deadline: Email or drop off your Civil Service Employee Application (resume is optional) on or before 4:00 p.m. on Monday, September 9, 2024.

Compensation: Starting: \$21.22 per hour. After six months: \$24.06 per hour. After one year: \$24.54 per hour. Additional raise after two years. (The current OCSEA union contract will be negotiated in 2024. Compensation increases will be determined at a later date.)

Additional Credit: Applicants who are residents of the State of Ohio, and who have been honorably discharge from active duty in the armed forces of the United States, are eligible to receive an additional credit of 20%. Credit is only given if a copy of the applicant's DD214 form indicating an 'honorable' discharge is submitted on or before 4:00 p.m. on Monday, September 9, 2024. (Ohio National Guard service is accepted for this with verification of active-duty participation.) Any military reserve member (in good standing) will receive an additional credit of 15% of their test grade with proper verification. A passing score of 70% is required to receive additional credit.
