RESOLUTION NO. 2024-100

A Resolution naming the ground surrounding the CA&C Depot, American Heritage Park; and declaring an emergency.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-103

A Resolution confirming the Mayor's re-appointment of William Smith as a regular member of the Board of Zoning Appeals; and declaring an emergency.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-104

A Resolution authorizing the Safety-Service Director to dispose of vehicles in the Police Department not needed for public use by the City of Mount Vernon; and declaring an emergency.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-42

An Ordinance with reference to the wages and benefits of bargaining unit employees and fixing the wages and benefits of bargaining unit employees of the City of Mount Vernon, Ohio; Dan Emmett Chapter of/and the Ohio Civil Service Employees Association, Local 11/American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, wages to be effective the first day of July 2024; and declaring an emergency.
